

L&T Construction Wins Orders Valued ` 3700 Cr

Mumbai, April 2, 2013: L&T Construction has secured new orders valued over ` 3700 crores across various business segments in March 2013.

The Building & Factories Business has bagged new orders worth ` 1986 crores for the construction of residential towers and commercial development across India.

The Power Transmission & Distribution Business has secured new orders worth ` 1097 crores. A major order was secured from Punjab State Power Corporation Limited for the execution of R-APDRP (Part B) Project on turnkey basis at Amritsar, Jalandhar and Ludhiana city.
